### **Leeds Royal Armouries visit**

On Monday 9<sup>th</sup> July 2018, the Humanities Department and I have arranged for Year 7 students to visit the Leeds Royal Armouries for the day. The trip will leave promptly at 8:30am and return to the Academy for approximately 3:15pm. Your child is asked to be at the Academy promptly for 8:15am and go straight to the main hall.

Students will undertake a range of activities put together by our History teachers in the Academy and this will build on the knowledge that they have learnt during their first year here at Ormiston Maritime Academy. Given the importance of the trip and its connections to the Key Stage 3 National Curriculum, the visit is being funded by the Academy and is therefore at no expense to parents/carers.

Students will need to bring a packed lunch and drinks (not fizzy or 'energy' drinks) as there are limited facilities at the museum to purchase food. Lunch will be provided by the Academy if your child is entitled to Free School Meals. Students are allowed to bring money to purchase items in the gift shop; but they are responsible for the safe keeping of any money that they bring with them.

Please let me take this opportunity to remind you that should your child's behaviour be below that of what we deem as acceptable within the Academy, then they will not be permitted to attend this visit.

Students will also be required to wear full Academy uniform for the trip, and be aware, that, by wearing this uniform in a public place, is acceptably representing the correct values and behaviour that we would expect of a student at Ormiston Maritime Academy.
